Scope of Work:

- The scope of work for the project is to construct a new bus transportation complex for Sayreville Public Schools for the maintenance and service of district buses and other vehicles. The building will have (4) service bays, administrative office space, storage space, and a space dedicated for Training and Drivers Lounge. The site will provide new asphalt parking for up to (85) buses. Separate parking areas will also be provided for bus driver and maintenance personal vehicles as well as parking for the buildings administrative staff. As an alternate bid, a key-fob activated fueling station will be located at the rear of the site to provide fuel for the buses. A new stormwater management system including retention basins will be included to control the added stormwater runoff from the paved areas.
